WILDORADO TRANSFER GUIDELINES:

- 1. Transfer is good for the 2019-2020 school year only and can be revoked at any time based upon attached criteria**, student transfer applications for the coming school year are accepted only after being evaluated each year prior to student enrollment at Wildorado ISD. Applications are placed on a waiting list in the order they are received.
2. Transfers received during the application period will be approved up to the school capacity. Transfers are permitted that do not exceed the desired enrollment for a grade level, school, or existing facility.
3. Applications turned in will be approved on one-for-one trades that do not exceed building or classroom desired capacity.
4. Students remain on the waiting list until an approval or exchange has been secured. **Parents will be notified when a transfer is approved or denied.** The review of transfer requests and notification is a continuous process.
5. An approved transfer establishes a priority for younger students wishing to attend the same school as an older sibling. Each request is considered on a case-by-case basis regardless of the number of children in the family. Where possible the district will attempt to keep whole families in the same school.
6. A new application is required for incoming kindergarteners or students wishing to transfer who are not currently on an approved transfer. Students currently on a valid, approved transfer may return at the school for succeeding years so long as they are in compliance with the attached requirements for behavior, tardiness, absenteeism, academics, and do not violate any of the other terms of the transfer.
- 7. A transfer may be revoked or denied at any time for poor student behavior, tardiness, absenteeism, academics or for any other violation of the terms of the transfer.**
8. The parent/guardian must provide transportation for approved transfer students to and from school.

9. In keeping with State Law, students may not use addresses of family, friends, or daycare to gain access into a school. All students are required to provide proof of resident address when enrolling. Proof of address must include escrow/real estate papers, valid rental agreement; current utility bill, cable or garbage bill, and driver's license or State ID card.

I agree that in so signing we (both parent and student) will comply with the guidelines and requirements stated in this agreement and if either fails to comply with these guidelines the transfer is revoked at the time so stated by Wildorado ISD, effective when deemed appropriate by the school district.
