How to qualify for *automatic* acceptance:

- Must be 4 years old on or before September 1st, 2020
- AND*
- Must meet 1 of the qualifications listed below (Documentation Needed):
 - Be unable to speak or comprehend the English language (Qualifying score on the OTPT)
 - Be educationally disadvantaged, which means a student eligible to participate in the national free or reduced lunch program (The past 2-3 paystubs of ALL household incomes, SNAP letter, or Income Tax if self-employed)
 - Be homeless, as defined by 42 United States Code (U.S.C) Section 1143a, regardless of residence of the child, or either parent of the child, or of the child's guardian or other person having lawful control of the child (Must fit the definition of homeless as defined by 42 United States Code (U.S.C) Section 1143a)
 - Be the child of an active duty member of the armed forces of the United States, including the state military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces, who is ordered to active duty by proper authority (Parent Military ID)
 - Be the child of a member of the armed forces of the United States, including the state military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces, who was injured or killed while serving on active duty (DD214 From, Letter from the US Dept. of VA)
 - Be in, or have been in, the conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services (DFPS) following an adversary hearing held as provided by Section 262.201, Family Code (Verification Letter from DFPS)
 - Be the child of a person eligible for the Star of Texas Award as a peace officer (3106.002), a firefighter (3106.003), or emergency medical first responder (3106.004) (Verification)

How to qualify for pre-k for those that do not fall under the automatic acceptance guidelines:

- Must be 4 years old on or before September 1st, 2020
- Submit a registration packet for review

Required Documentation for Registration

- Birth Certificate
- Current Immunization Records
- Social Security Card for Student
- Proof of residence - gas, electric bill (within the last 30 days of registration), mortgage or lease agreement.
- Parent/Guardian Driver's License
- Any legal paperwork (custody)
