



Dress and Grooming (All Grade Levels)

The district's dress code teaches grooming and hygiene while promoting a positive learning climate. Students and parents may determine a student's personal dress and grooming standards, if they comply with the following:

- All shirts must cover the chest, midriff, shoulders, and back.
- Pants, jeans, or capris are to be worn at the waist at all times (no sagging).
 - No baggy pants or pants with zippers other than the one on the front.
 - No pajama pants except for on approved spirit days.
 - Shorts and skirts must be as long as the tip of the index finger.
 - See-through garments must have an appropriate undergarment.
- Footwear: Must be worn at all times. House shoes/slippers are not permitted.
- Hair shall be clean, well groomed, and not interfere with eyes being visible nor vision being obstructed. Hairstyles that are distracting, as determined by the Wildorado ISD administration, are not be permitted. Hair must be of a natural color. No designs shaved or cut into the hair.
- Beards, mustaches, or goatees must be well groomed. Sideburns are not to be longer than the bottom of the ear lobe. Notched/slit eyebrows are not permitted.
 - Headgear (caps, hats, hoods, scarves, bandanas, etc.) and sunglasses are NOT permitted.
- Piercings: Facial piercing, limited to a single nostril is permitted. No jewelry shall connect from the face to the ear nor any other article. Tongue piercings are not permitted.
- No clothing/bags/etc. with wording or images representing alcohol, tobacco, drugs, vaping, explicit material, profanity, nor any other inappropriate subject.
 - Tattoos: Tattoos on the face or neck are not permitted.
